WHAT A PRAYER!

This well known, but I am afraid, seldom prayed prayer, comes from a man whom the Lord said, "was more honorable than his brethren." Jabez, a man whose very name was given to him because of sorrow, came from a burden to be a blessing. That just goes to show you that our start doesn't have to determine our finish, Hallelujah! He had such a desire to do more for God that God couldn't finish the Jewish lineages without stopping to say something about it. While his prayer was five-tier as he prayed, "bless me, enlarge me, fill me, keep me and encourage me," I noticed one thing about his character toward the end of his prayer. He said, "that it may not grieve me!" My heart was captured by the little word, "grieve". It means to carve or fashion, to pain or make angry, to displease, hurt, or to make or be sorry. This told me a little about how Jabez would be affected if God *didn't* answer his prayer. This word "grieve" is the same Hebrew word used as "worship" in Jer. 44:19 where Jeremiah is referring to Israel's worshipping of a false god. It is also the same Hebrew word as "vexed" in Isa. 63:10 when Israel vexed His Holy Spirit. Do you see the correlation? Jabez was in such a place in his life, that if God didn't answer his prayer, it would be to him as if he were worshipping a false god & the Spirit of God would be vexed because this prayer is what God wanted for Jabez to begin with. He has so died to self that he will be pained, hurt, made sorry, & displeased if God does not grant him this prayer. WOW! No wonder he was more honorable than his brethren! Would to God more of us could be "grieved" if we don't get to do more for Jesus. —Bro. Orange
