We were thrilled to get to help out in Weslaco, Tx. with some local visitation with the Open Door Baptist Church. God really helped in the revival services the next week, even with my inadequacies to be able to speak Spanish! This was my first time preaching with an interpreter so it started out as a bit of a challenge. But God soon grafted our hearts together and many were able to get help from God's word. This church is now also part of our newest support in the ministry. We are so thankful to them and our Lord for helping to supply our needs as we travel and spread the gospel and help churches and pastors. We are also thankful for the Mt. Pisgah Baptist Church in Traphill, NC for taking us on for support back in December. We weren't able to publish in our last newsletter about this but we are so grateful to them as well.

Before we left out for our trip in January, God came through and supplied for our need for a trailer to haul our vehicle on! The cost ended up being \$7,000 when all was said and done. We ended up having to get a custom-built 17 foot aluminum trailer instead of the original 14 footer. We are so thankful to everyone who heeded to God's voice as He spoke to hearts about supplying the need. All we did was ask, and God supplied, praise His name!

We were able to make it back across the country to Florida from Texas for a portion of February and what a time it was getting into 6 different churches throughout the state. We were also able to do some outreach with the Grace Baptist Temple in Fort Myers, Fla. The Lord willing, we'll go back in May as well for a meeting. We then moved on up through Georgia where we were privileged to help 3 more churches, finishing up February and moving into March. We also got to help with the startup of Living Waters Baptist Church in Cobbtown, Ga. on our final stretch of the trip by doing some door to door outreach and flier distribution. We're scheduled to be back there in April as well for a week long meeting—Hallelujah!

Throughout the course of this past trip, God has opened many other doors for us to get into many other churches in the coming months. We are so excited to see what God is going to do in these upcoming meetings. Please continue to pray for God's guidance and wisdom to help these churches and pastors. Without our Lord Jesus' help, we can do NOTHING!
